

How a competition is run

About 10 days before a competition the Mail truck, the UPS truck and perhaps the Fed X truck show up and your front hall looks like this.



How they arrive

Once they have all arrived the packages get opened and spread out by club.



Opened and piled by club

First we sort the color entries. We take one from club 1 one from club 2 and so on. Then we do the same with the monochromes, **ending up with just two piles.**

With this method entries from the same maker or club do not come up consecutively during the judging.



Color & Monochrome piles

The entries are then brought to the competition. (I use a plastic bin to transport them and bubble wrap to protect them.)

They get passed in front of the judges.



Club Night Judging

The scorekeeper records the score

As they are taken away from the judges they are placed in piles by club. This way they are being unsorted at the judging, might as well only handle them once.

They are then placed into the original boxes and mailed back.



Waiting for the Postman

The scores get e-mailed to the Competition Director & the Entry fees get mailed to the Treasurer.
